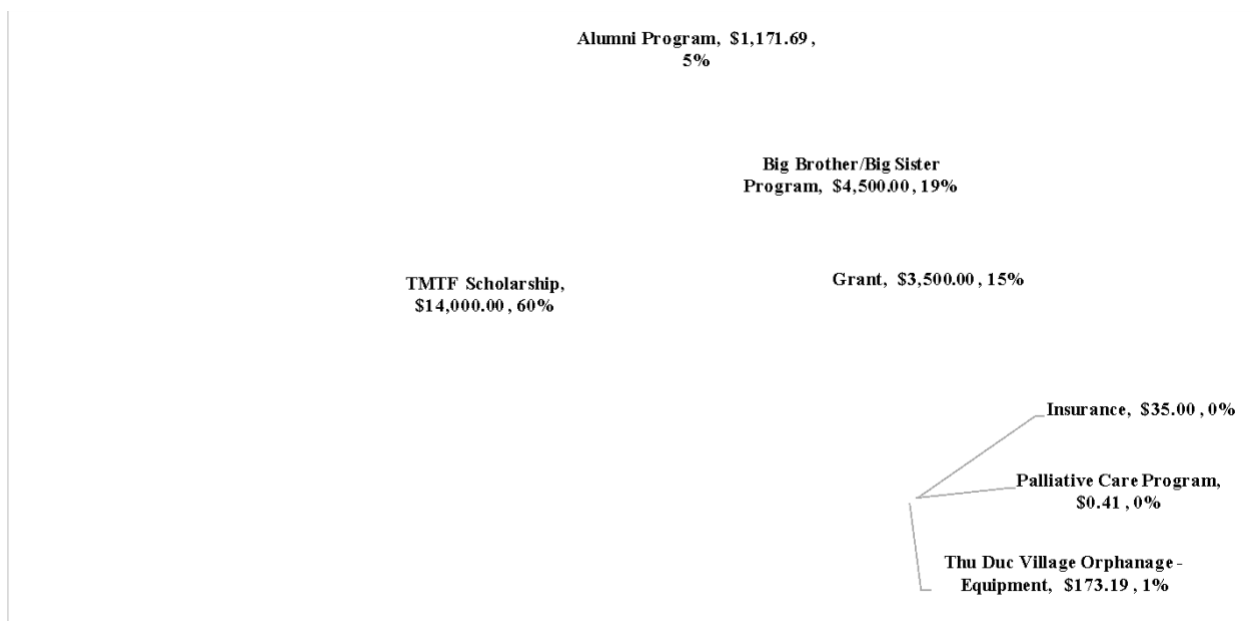


During 2016-2017, the Union of North American Vietnamese Student Associations (UNAVSA) Collective Philanthropy Project (CPP) raised a total of \$113,250 for Kids Without Borders and their project Teach Me To Fish. Since then, UNAVSA CPP and Kids Without Borders have been working together to ensure the donations are utilized to provide support for orphans to have a better chance to becoming healthy, functional, and productive adults.

As of February 1, 2018, UNAVSA CPP has made the fourth installment payment (4 out of 7) of \$25,000 to Kids Without Borders. As of January 3, 2019 Kids Without Borders has utilized the total amount. During the fourth wave, the donated amount was used to support the project in the following areas:



Utilizing the money provided by UNAVSA, Kids Without Borders hosted a reunion event for their Alumni Program, purchased various equipment for the Thu Duc Village and Hoa Phuong Orphanages. Kids Without Borders was also able to award nineteen scholarship to members of their program.

1) Introduction:

Founded in 2001, Kids Without Borders (KWB) is an all-volunteer international non-governmental organization based in Washington State. Their mission is to “inspire and involve youth in service worldwide”. Kids Without Borders has provided opportunities for thousands of youth and their families to volunteer and serve others in their communities and in many developing countries around the world. Kids Without Borders’ local programs and projects benefit low-income students in school districts, surrounding communities, and social service programs; as well as refugees and immigrants. Their international programs and projects benefit victims of natural disasters, orphans, street children, children and people in developing countries. More than 90% of Kids Without Borders’ international programs and projects are in Viet Nam.

In Vietnam, orphans leave the care of the orphanage at the age of eighteen. Many of these orphans face the risk of ending up living in poverty, becoming victim of crimes, being trafficked, and forced into marriage. Teach Me to Fish focuses on an exit plan for these orphans after the orphanage. It provides them with a better chance to come health, functional, and productive adults.

2) Kids Without Borders’ Progress Report of Teach Me To Fish:

1. Emergency Shelter
 - a. In October, KWB provided a grant for an emergency shelter
2. Scholarship
 - a. KWB awarded eleven Teach Me to Fish scholarships.
 - b. KWB awarded three Big Brother/Big Sister scholarships.
3. Alumni Program
 - a. In October, KWB held two reunion meeting and dinner.
4. Palliative Care Program
 - a. In October, KWB purchased various medications.

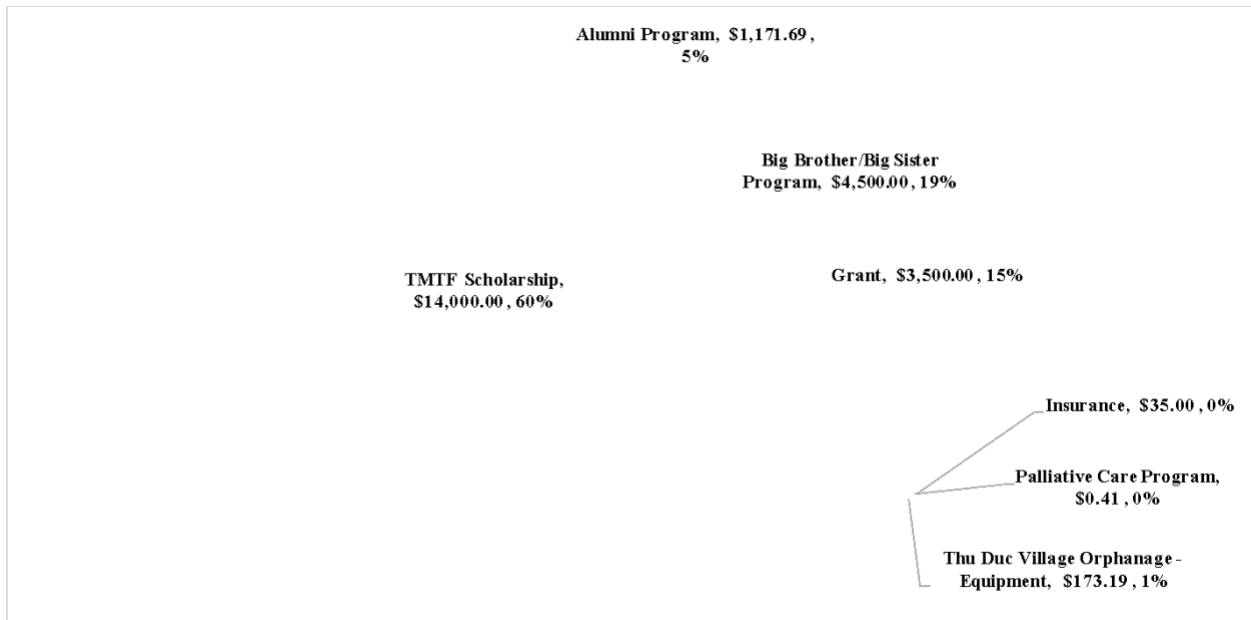
